A word from your pastor....

My Beloved Church Family,

The Easter Season is upon us. Of all of our holidays, Easter is the most important and most special. Christians believe that the death and resurrection of Jesus changed the world not just at a historical level — which it clearly did — but also at a supernatural level. By willingly going to the cross and then rising from the dead, Jesus of Nazareth, who is the Son of God, somehow tweaked the constants of the spiritual universe, so that sin and death are, by this action, in a fundamental way, destroyed. The tragedy of the cross is eclipsed by the glory of eternal life!

If the crucifixion was about everything that is bad about the world, Easter is about how we can be free from everything bad. For Christians, Easter commemorates the fact that, supernaturally, the resurrection of Jesus Christ changed something



flawed about the world and about humanity. In the end, the meaning of Easter is as simple as it seems: it says that life triumphs over death.

When something wonderful happens, we *need* to celebrate the fact. On Palm Sunday Night, our choir,

orchestra and drama team will lead us in the Living Lord's Supper. Good Friday Night, our student ministry will lead out in a celebration entitled, "It is finished!" Then, on Easter Sunday Morning, in both services we will celebrate that victory that God brought about. The empty tomb and the risen Lord vindicated every promise about Messiah. Plan to celebrate with us and invite a friend to come and glory in what God alone could accomplish.


