Remembering Geoffrey

On December 7, 2017, I received a text from Dr. Geoffrey McGillen, asking me to drive him to the emergency room. Soon, he was joined by his beloved wife, Mary. We knew he did not feel well, but all assumed some antibiotics and oxygen would bring him back to vigor in a matter of days.

Sadly, this was not the case. The next morning on December 8, 2017, I received the news that he had gone home to be with the Lord.

What a shock that news was! Just two nights before, Bro. Geoffrey had accompanied the choir in anticipation of our Christmas worship. He loved using his vast talent to praise the Lord and that was true with both the Sanctuary Choir and the Praise Team. He was equally talented and energetic with both genres. Suddenly, that enthusiastic, unique laugh was no longer to be heard in the office. Our seniors adored the love and attention that Bro. Geoffrey lavished upon

For over twenty years Geoffrey McGillen ministered to children learning to play piano. He tirelessly led Young At Heart and visited nursing homes. For those who knew him well, the loving encouragement and faithfulness of Mary Shannon McGillen served as his muse. They met over music. He retained a cassette of the concert between their first and second kiss.

Dr. Geoffrey McGillen will be missed. Our staff family and our church family as a whole will forever cherish our memories of him. Geoffrev loved using music to inspire and draw people closer to God. Occasionally, that happened in a day room at a nursing home. Regularly, he was jamming with the Praise Team. The greatest lesson of his life and unexpected passing is this: no one knows when we will be called home with the Lord, but we must use each and every day to the fullest in order to glorify our Savior and draw others to Him.

Our Boomer Plus ministry Barnabas is pleased to announce a new volunteer Crisis **Counseling Service called** "The Barnabas Ministry".

How it works: Our pastors will utilize the Barnabas Ministry Counselors to provide individual counseling services. The Barnabas Ministry team is made up of men and women who are trained in Christian Counseling and have agreed to serve voluntarily. Barnabas Counselors will assist our Pastoral Staff with persons they refer in need of crisis and ongoing counseling.

What will be available: Members of the Barnabas Counseling team have all completed an intensive counseling training program over the past year with over forty hours of individual and group supervision under the leadership of a licensed therapist. The team intensively studied a Christian Counseling program model to equip them for the delivery of these services.

Services available include individual counseling to men and women ages eighteen and above. The services will be offered for up to six appointments per calendar year. These counseling services will initially be offered only at the Church campus at appointment times that are agreed upon between the counselor and those receiving services.

Cost of services: All services are available at no cost to any person referred by pastoral staff. This service is a part of the Boomer Plus Ministry but is not limited to Boomer age recipients. Church membership is not a requirement.

How to receive these services: All persons receiving services must access the Barnabas Ministry initially through a referral by one of our staff Ministers. After sharing that need with pastoral staff, the person requesting service must be referred by that Minister to the Barnabas Counseling team. A member of the Barnabas Ministry team will then contact the person requesting service to schedule an initial meeting.

Confidentiality: All counseling will be considered highly confidential. Information shared with a counselor cannot and will not be shared with anyone else including the member of church staff who initially made the referral to the counseling team.

Start Date: This program will be available mid-Jan. 2018. Watch for a program insert in your Sunday bulletin announcing the start and introducing our counselors.
