A word from your pastor....

My Beloved Church Family,

I am so very excited about the NATIONAL DAY OF PRAYER this year.

Our theme this year is For Your Great Name's Sake! Hear Us ...Forgive Us ...Heal Us! This is inspired by Daniel 9:19. Daniel was a captive refugee, one who had been ripped from everything dear to him. Daniel was conscripted into service of the very empire which had destroyed his land, even as they were attempting to destroy his culture. And so, even as we must, Daniel resorted to prayer in his time of need and desperation. He acknowledged the powerful mercy of God in the past. Then, he owned the sin which had prompted God's wrath to fall upon him.

"O Lord, hear! O Lord, forgive! O Lord, listen and take action! For Thine own sake, O my God, do not delay, because Thy city and Thy people are called by Thy name." -- Daniel 9:19 (NASB77)



There was no attempt at justifying the sin which led to the exile. The nation had received what they justly deserved. Then, in the midst of his prayer of confession, God sent him Gabriel to clarify God's plans and His eventual mercy upon the nation. The
