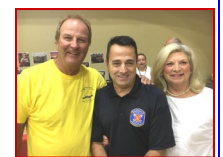


Saturday, Sept. 7 at 1:00 p.m. – BBQ For Badges & their Families

My beloved church family,

Seven busy weeks!!! That is the only way to describe July 27 through September 8, 2019. Kingdom is not defined by how full a calendar is, but rather by the potential to touch and change lives. In short, busy days alone are not our objective. However, sometimes it is important to celebrate doors of opportunity which the Lord has opened before us.

In July, we hosted an event for the young men who regularly play basketball in the gym on Sunday Nights. This summer Mark George has also offered periodic opportunities though the course of the week. We wanted to go beyond the basketball courts, so we planned a BBQ for players, families and their pastors. Very few of these young men are plugged into a church, but we wanted to connect.

In August, we reached out to the South Asian population of the Louisville Metropolitan Area, with over 200 Hindus hearing the Gospel in conjunction with their patriotic observance of Indian Independence from England. Our people worked behind the scenes so Indian Christians could lead in song, dance, and the sharing of the Gospel.

August 23-25, 2019, we were the host venue for the "State of the Kingdom Experience," an effort to bring together denominations and people from various racial backgrounds together. It was so well-received and attended. Our church, by offering our plant, is helping to breakdown the lines of separation which have divided the races for over a century.



Finally, our First Responder Weekend is almost here. I can walk into a firehouse or bump into an EMT and people look forward to this special corporate thank-you. It's a joy to see God at work. Slowly but inevitably, we are changing the way Shelbyville perceives our church. And that is a change for the better.

We are still seeing the Boomers do great things. Our student ministry has never been stronger, even as we go through a time of transition in leadership. Men's and Women's ministries are thriving. 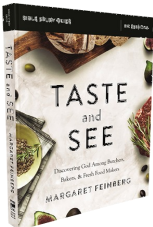
